READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE COMMENCING THIS ACTIVITY.

General Notes

To aid in installation the correct order of accessory installation needs to be observed:

- 1. Install all electrical components first.
- 2. Install Vehicle Tub Sealing Kit.
- 3. Install vehicle tub protective products such as tub liners*.
- 4. Install styling bar onto Sportlid.
- 5. Install the Sportlid Fitting Kit.
- 6. Install the Sportlid.
- 7. Install any additional accessories such as roof racks.

*Sportlid is compatible with under rail and Sport Guard style tub liners. Some trimming may be required. OEM liner compatibility cannot be guaranteed. Please contact your dealer for more information.

- Read through the fitting instructions before installation of accessory.
- Check that the contents of the Fitting Kit are complete and undamaged.
- If any contents of the Fitting Kit are found incomplete or damaged they must be replaced using the specified accessory components.
- Always install the accessory following the fitting instructions. Failure to do so may cause damage to the vehicle or the
 accessory and void the warranty.
- Ensure all recyclable discarded vehicle/accessory components and packaging are disposed following local recycling regulations.
- Safely store and protect any removed vehicle components.
- Ensure all bare metal surfaces are protected using Automotive Bare Metal Primer and touch-up paint.
- · Remove all metal swarf and dust from all vehicle surfaces if surface is used for accessory installation.
- Ensure all fasteners are torqued to the specifications as per instruction.
- Apply any adhesives to the vehicle only when the surface temperature is between 20°C to 40°C.
- Sportlid: Recommended all smooth lids are painted. Failure to paint lid will void the warranty.
- Bedliner: Recommended rust preventative solution be applied to vehicle surfaces before installation.

- For correct installation and proper operation of the vehicle and accessory we recommend this accessory is fitted by a
 qualified Technician.
- During the accessory fitment ensure all automotive safety practices and regulations are followed.

Step 1

- Lay Sportlid upside down on a soft, non-scratch surface.
- If upgrading an existing lid, it is strongly recommended the lid is removed from the vehicle before commencing.



Step 2

 Locate the spade terminals of the central locking lid loom (item 1). Run these down through the hole in the front corner of the frame.


Note: Hole location can vary between LH & RH side depending on vehicle model.



Step 3

- Draw the loom through until the grommet pops into place in the frame hole.
- Depending on vehicle model the loom hole will be located in either the LHS or RHS front corner of the lid.







Step 4

 Using a hex key, unfasten each end of the removable support clamping plates.

Note: some older models will use an 'L' shaped bracket with wing-nut & washer.



Step 5

Remove the support by prising it out of its locating slots.
 Push downward and twist to either side.





Step 6

· Feed the entire loom through the support.

Note: A draw cord or wire may be required.





Step 7

- Relocate the support into its slots.
- Relocate and fasten support brackets.
- · Maximum recommended torque is 4Nm.



Step 8

 Remove the service cover by removing the two button head bolts shown.

Note: Take care when peeling away service cover from rubber seal as these are magnetized together.

Alternatively, remove the plastic service cover (model dependant).



Step 9

 Using a 4mm hex key, remove the cable cam on the back of the handle by unfastening the central bolt.

Note: Take care not to misplace bolt or washers.





Step 10

- Carefully slide locking module (item 2) onto handle lock barrel in the orientation shown.
- Ensure the module is securely located on the shoulder of the handle.





Step 11

- Locate cir-clip (item 6) to the left of the lock barrel in its corresponding slot.
- Using a long flat screwdriver, lever the cir-clip across into position.

TIP: The handle fasteners can be loosened to allow the handle to move, this creates extra room when installing the cir-clip.

Once cir-clip is installed re-tighten fasteners to 5Nm.



Step 12

Plug spade terminals onto locking module as shown.

GREEN = Lock - Indicated by 'L' on the module

BLUE = Unlock - Indicated by 'U' on the module


Step 13

Locate and re-fasten the cable cam in reverse of step 9.

Note: Ensure cam and washers are central when fastening.

Note: Check that the latches are synchronised. If not refer adjustment instructions at the end of this document.

Note: Ensure cable cam is installed in the correct orientation.



Step 14

Relocate service cover that was removed in step 8.






Step 15

 Using cleaning wipe (item 8) and one primer stick (item 5), clean and prime a small area on the underside of the frame, between the handle and support.











Step 16

With the same wipe and primer stick, clean and prime two small areas on the underside (opposite surface to image) of the frame between the grommet and support.








Step 17

Stick the cable tie mounts (item 4) to the primed areas on the frame. Fasten loom to the mounts with cable ties (item 3).

Note: Ensure any excess loom length is cabletied at the rear of the lid (handle end) and not the front by the grommet.



Step 18

- Sit LED light (item 7) onto the SPORTLID in desired position. Image shows recommended position only.
- Wipe area clean with cleaning rag or alcohol wipe from step 16.
- Remove LED light and prime (item 5) the area underneath.

Step 19

 Remove adhesive backing & stick light in chosen, primed position. Firm pressure to wet out the tape needs to be applied.



Step 20

 Using the SPORTLID key, ensure handle is now in the unlocked position.



Step 21


- Connect the lid to the vehicle central locking via the central locking harness supplied in kit 1 of 2.
- Test the remote locking actuator using the vehicles FOB and ensures its locking is syncronised with that of the vehicle.
- Push the remote lock button on the key FOB to unlock twice.

Adjustment 1

- Test handle and lock assembly to ensure the latches function correctly.
- Ensure latches are synchronised.
- If latching synchronisation or sensitivity requires adjusting the cable tension can be increased or decreased.
- Loosen the lock nut and rotate the barrel adjuster anti-clockwise to increase cable tension or clock-wise to decrease cable tension.
- If there is insufficient adjustment at sides, see next step.



Adjustment 2

- Loosen the lock nut and rotate the barrel adjuster anti-clockwise to increase cable tension or clock-wise to decrease cable tension.
- Adjust the cable tension so that the latches operate simultaneously.
- · Ensure the lock nut is securely fastened.
- · Re-install the service cover when finished.
